

**Erratum: Angular Tunneling Ionization Probability of Fixed-in-Space H₂ Molecules
in Intense Laser Pulses
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After publication we became aware of an error in how we referenced previous experiments to obtain molecular frame angular distributions.

In this context, the Letters by Litvinyuk *et al.* and Pavičić *et al.* (Refs. [6,7] of our Letter) were used incorrectly.

Instead we should have cited the recent experiments by Kumarappan *et al.* [1] and Meckel *et al.* [2]. To the best of our knowledge both works constitute the first and so far only measurements of photoelectron angular distributions from multiphoton ionization of aligned molecules.
