

INFORMATION FOR CONTRIBUTORS

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Length. There is a 50-page limit on the length of regular reviews and a 20-page limit on colloquia. One journal page equals approximately three typed, double-spaced pages or four figures.

Refereeing. Submitted articles will be referred to one or more associate editors in appropriate fields. An initial decision will be made on the timeliness of the topic and breadth of appeal to our readership. Articles meeting these criteria are reviewed by outside referees who evaluate the scientific accuracy, balance, and clarity of the manuscript. Authors can expect some additional editing in light of these referee reports before the final manuscript is accepted.

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
